MDT will lead *Phase 3* of this pooled fund study and is seeking partners.

Since 2014, the Montana Department of Transportation (MDT) has led the pooled fund study, a partnership between 20 states and the Center for Health and Safety Culture (CHSC) at Montana State University as the principal research entity. Topics have included driving under the influence (alcohol and cannabis), proactive traffic safety, the role of law enforcement, seat belt use, speeding and aggressive driving, distracted driving, and pedestrian safety.
